E motion (*i.e.*, depression)

A norexia (nervosa or tardive), Alcoholism, Abuse (elder)

L ate-life paranoia or alcoholism

S wallowing disorders

N o money, Nosocomial infections

W andering and other dementia-related behaviors

H yperthyroidism, Hyperparathyroidism, Hypoadrenalism, Hyperglycemia

E ntry problems/Malabsorption
