A. **636** and 637 (second reading)

New program proposal were approved unanimously, no abstention.

B. **668**

The SOM proposed an MS in Medical Science as a new degree that will replace the MAPP PBC. Johan Becker presented the proposal to the committee and announced the change. The change will enable SOM to offer a program to prepare students for medical school having more in-line instructional content and more likely to help students succeed in their application to medical school. Such a program will be more appealing to administration committee. Career and academic opportunities will also be provided.

This new program proposal was unanimously approved.

The proposed PBC proposal, which added material requested by GAAC in February, was reviewed by Dr. Tree in preparation for the meeting. Dr. Chang indicated he decided to come from the perspective of a colleague familiar with the market.

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Question about availability and requirements for online or in-person correction for the program were raised. Helen Lach suggested adding a specific provision for online delivery; it is proposed to add an amendment removing the online option from the in-person requirements. Dr. Tree noted that if there is a change in procedure from in-person to online, a modal correction proposal will be required.

There was unanimous approval for the Public Health Certification.

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Dr. Mae Nane presented a pre-enrollment program change proposal. GAAC noted the following changes: 1) cannot take advantage of independent standards, and 2) the program must provide an individualized education plan for the program office.

The program change proposal was approved, contingent upon the following modification.

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Dr. Wendy Sa presented a plain OT program change proposal. She indicated OT is working toward changing accreditation standard, and described some of the changes. In addition, the new OT program is currently listed as
